

This will give you 1 POW tag. Make sure to turn off "fit to paper" in the printer settings. Cut at crop marks shown on the front of the form. Note that the two top corners are also cut off. The original tag was made of a plastic coated fabric material. It had a hole punched where the + is. It had a metal grommet & a cardboard reinforcement piece. This could probably be duplicated by a banner company. For most purposes, this can probably be printed on card stock & a reinforcement ring stuck on both sides of the hole.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

1. This tag will be accomplished at the division collecting point (or by the capturing unit or at such other point as the division commander shall prescribe) at which point each prisoner of war will be tagged (loop cord around neck).
2. Prisoners of war will be warned not to mutilate, destroy, or lose their tags.
